We write all assignments everyday on the board, and we expect students to copy down assignments in their assignment book. Please check their agenda book daily, and sign it. Feel free to make notes to us in these books. There may be occasional notes from us as well.

School supplies~ The school supply list might have seemed long, but we have found that supplies are much cheaper at this time. Some items will be collected and saved for use later in the year.

Harmony is a great way to monitor your child's progress. You should see approximately two grades per week per subject. We may not "grade" every paper that they bring home. We like to allow them time to practice, self correct, and review. We also may take a grade for participation. Students will get points in the grade book for contributing to the class discussion.
