Skills Being Practiced this Month:

ELA - story structure, point of view, compare/contrast, sequence of events, inferences/drawing conclusions, prefixes, suffixes

Math - measurement (time, liquid volume, mass, temperature) and various problem solving activities involving measurement & the 4 operations (add, subtract, divide, & multiply)
