The Networks Scholarship, created through a grant from the Lilly Endowment, Inc., is for students studying for a career in business and financial services – all majors in the Scott College of Business are eligible.

To be eligible to apply, students must be admitted as an incoming freshman to Indiana State. Qualified students should possess two of the following three criteria:

1. A cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 on a 4.0 scale
2. An 1140 SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math) or 23 ACT
3. Ranking in the top 15% of the senior class

Please note, a student must have applied and been accepted to Indiana State by December 1st to access the application. Completed Networks applications, including all required materials are **due by December 15th**.
