TONIGHT'S OPPONENT:

The Mustangs finished second to Rockville in 2012-13 and we hope to be in the hunt for a conference championship again. While the Rox graduated many good players, I still wouldn't be shocked to see them perform better this year than many would expect. Covington probably returns the most overall talent in the league and would have to be considered a favorite this season. Attica also returns several quality players and should challenge for a league title. Seeger graduated a lot of their scoring, but some young players stepped up toward the end of last season. North Vermillion has the best athlete in the conference in Brayden Woodard and several young players who gained a lot of varsity experience last year to go with him. They could be one of the top teams in the conference. Riverton Parke graduated only three players from last year, though Matt Haltom was a tough one to lose. The conference seems a little more wide-open than the last two years, and the Mustangs hope to be involved in that fight for the title.
