### LAST WEEK IN MUSTANG BASKETBALL:

Senior night was a successful night for the Mustangs. Senior Kiowa Simonton (10 points) was among 5 players in double figures. Clayton Corey had a career high 19 points; Ethan Woodrow scored 17; Doug Wallace had 14 points and 13 rebounds; Koby Pierce added 10 as well. The Mustangs jumped out to a 21-2 lead at the end of the first quarter and never looked back. We posted our second highest field goal percentage for a game (52%) and one of our best free throw shooting performances (thanks to Clayton Corey's 9/10 shooting at the line).
