The Mustangs' boys basketball program helped Fountain Central capture the fourth sectional championship of this school year. Championships have also been won this year in football, boys' tennis, and girls' swimming. It has been an exciting year for Mustang Athletics!

SATURDAY'S OPPONENT - TIPTON BLUE DEVILS:

For the second time in 3 years, we will be facing the Tipton Blue Devils in the regional. Tipton features one of the most prolific-scoring guards in Mason Degenkolb (23ppg). He is an excellent 3-pt shooter and a great driver as well. Defending his will be crucial. In the paint, Nate Friend (13ppg) is a strong post player who can post up or drive.

The Blue Devils will be one of the most physical defensive teams we have faced this season. We must take care of the basketball to have a chance to win. They are also an excellent rebounding team, so our size will be put to the test in this game.



SECTIONAL RECAP:

MUSTANGS 42 - RIVERTON PARKE 33

Coach Charlie Martin used some Box & 1 and Triangle & 2 defenses to slow down Ethan Woodrow and Koby Pierce for the Mustangs. It worked fairly well as the Mustangs struggled to get their offense going and Woodrow was held to a season-low 7 points. Pierce, however, made four 3-pointers and collected 3 steals on his way to a team-leading 15 points as the Mustangs survived the first round of the sectional.



MUSTANGS 67 - SEEGER 45

The Mustangs got off to a blistering start in game 2, shooting 70% from the field in the first half and leading 39-10 at half time. For the first time this season, the Mustangs shot over 60% from the field for the game. Ethan Woodrow got back into rhythm, as he scored 25 points to go with 10 rebounds and 2 blocks. Pierce had another big performance with 17 points, 4 rebounds, 7 assists, and 2 steals. Point guard Clayton Corey added 12 points and 4 assists, as he did a terrific job harassing Seeger guard Borden Kennedy throughout the game. Doug Wallace added 8 points and 10 rebounds off the bench.



MUSTANGS 53 - SOUTHMONT 47

The championship game was tight for three quarters until the Mustangs opened up a 12-point lead early in the 4th quarter. From there, Fountain Central held on to the ball and survived uncharacteristically missing several free throws late in the game. Ethan Woodrow exploded for 30 points and 11 rebounds in the championship game. Koby Pierce had his 3rd consecutive big night, scoring 15 points to go with 4 rebounds, 3 assists, and 2 steals. Senior Kiowa Simonton played great on the defensive end and grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds in the winning effort.
