



FOUNTAIN CENTRAL JR/SR HIGH SCHOOL 2020 INDOOR EVENTS COVID-19 INFORMATION - UPDATED 11/16/2020

After meeting with the health department and other administrators in our county, Fountain Central is announcing the following guidelines for indoor winter extracurricular events. This plan is effective November 16, 2020.

Limited Attendance:

- Attendees will be limited to parents/guardians of participants.
- Vouchers for visitors - opposing ADs will be sent vouchers, which they will distribute to parents/guardians/siblings of participants only.
 - **MAIN GYM** - parents/guardians/siblings of participants only.
 - **POOL** - NO visiting fans (home - 2 parents/guardians/siblings of participants only).
 - **ELEM GYM** - parents/guardians/siblings of participants only.
 - **AUX GYM** - ONE parent/guardian per participant only
- Concessions will be candy bars, drinks, and pre-packaged items only.

Seating

- **MAIN GYM** - visitor parents/guardians/siblings are asked to sit behind the benches in both the upper and lower sections, in family cohorts, socially distanced. Home parents/guardians/siblings are asked to sit opposite the benches and in the Mustang Club section, socially distanced. There will be no student section at this time.
- **ELEMENTARY GYM** - visitor fans are asked to sit in family cohorts in the bleachers opposite the visitor bench. Home fans are asked to sit opposite the home bench.
- **POOL**- We will not be allowing visitor fans to attend swim meets until further notice. Home fans are limited to parents/guardians of participants.
- **AUX GYM** - Due to space constraints, any event in the AUX gym will be limited to ONE parent/guardian per participant.

Screening

- All participants, coaches, and support staff must complete a health screen on site, which will include a temperature check.
- All visiting participants must complete a health screening, which includes a temperature check prior to entering the venue.
- Anyone exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19, or who has been exposed to someone with symptoms or a positive test result should stay at home.



Masking

- All attendees are required to wear masks at all times inside. Athletes may remove masks for strenuous activities.

Post Event

- All attendees are asked to exit the venue as soon as possible and refrain from congregating in hallways, gyms, etc. at the conclusion of each game.

Other
