All submissions must be typed in 12 point font and double spaced. In 300- 600 words, the applicant must expand upon the following questions in an essay format:

- Describe your most important 4-H experiences, accomplishments and contributions.
- What impact has 4-H had on your educational, career or personal goals? Include any other personal information you believe the selection committee should know when considering your application.
- Tell us what makes you a qualified candidate for the Pauline Payne Memorial Scholarship.
