We focus mainly on Fountain, Montgomery and Warren counties but provide services to our contiguous counties as well.

To further the promotion of habitat stewardship the Coal Creek Chapter will again award \$500.00 scholarships to college bound seniors from our service area.

Application Requirements:

1. Applicants must provide a short cover letter of introduction to themselves that includes an indication of their planned course of study in college.
2. Applicants must write a 250-500 word essay on the subject **"In your opinion what is the most important local environmental issue and how would you remedy it"** Essays should be typed and double spaced. No E-mail submissions please.
3. Applicant's college course of study should include classes in at least one of the following areas: Biology, Botany, Entomology, Conservation Law Enforcement, Environmental Engineering or Science, Forestry, Horticulture, Limnology, Marine Biology, Parks Management, Natural Resources or Wildlife Management.
4. Applicant should have a minimum 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale) and must include a school generated copy of their transcript.
5. Applicant must provide a copy of a letter of acceptance to their intended institution.
