Scholarship Information

The scholarship information presented below has been obtained over the course of the past year. Most opportunities have been confirmed to be available again this year; however, each year new scholarships are added and some are deleted. **Therefore, the following information may not be completely accurate for the current school year. If current year confirmation has not been received, deadlines listed are based on the previous year's deadline.** It is important to check back often throughout the year to be certain you stay informed with the most recent list of opportunities. This information will be updated regularly and available on the school website, guidance bulletin board, and in the Guidance Office.

Scholarship Application Guidelines

1. Follow the application directions exactly! Some applications are eliminated from consideration because the applicant did not follow the directions.
2. Meet the stated deadline. Late applications are usually not accepted.
3. Once you have decided on a college, check with their financial aid office and the department office (Liberal Arts, Engineering, etc.) for all scholarship opportunities.
4. Check the bulletin board weekly and *Hoofprints* each month.
5. Do not limit yourself to this list. Seek out information on the internet (www.finaid.org, www.studentscholarships.org), at the public library, etc.
6. Beware of scams! Generally, if you have to pay a fee to apply or pay money for someone else to do a search for you, it is probably not a good idea.
7. Apply to college as early as possible. Most schools will contact you about scholarships for which you are eligible once you have been accepted.
8. Do not wait until the last minute. You should ask for letters of recommendation at least two weeks ahead of the deadline.

IMPORTANT:

- Make sure all parts of your scholarship applications are completed properly and on time.
- Submit all forms to your counselor at least one week ahead of the deadline.
- Make copies for your files.
- Opportunities are categorized by local, state and national levels. Be sure to review the entire document. Each level is sorted according to the due date.
